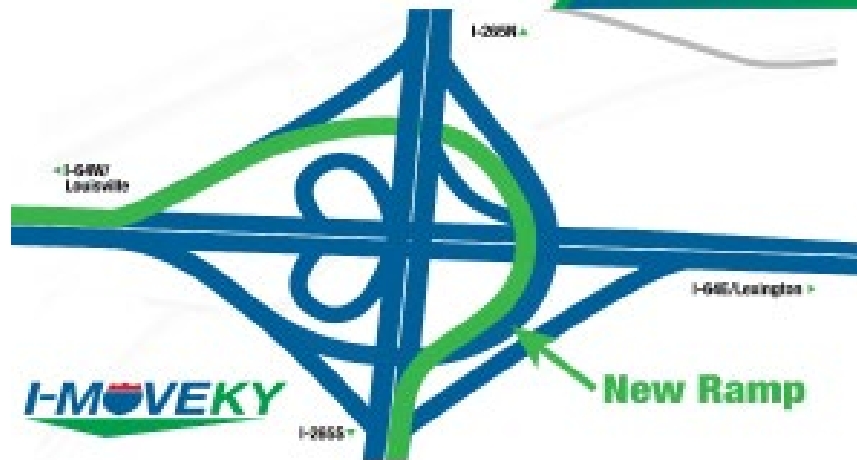

### Final flyover ramp opened from I-265 North to I-64 West

On Monday, August 5, the final flyover ramp for the I-Move Kentucky project was officially opened. This new ramp facilitates traffic from I-265 North to I-64 West, replacing one of the older cloverleaf ramps. The transition to the flyover design enhances safety, improves traffic flow, and increases mobility for commuters.

## Making strides on Interstate 71

There has been a lot of work going on around I-71 lately! Crews have recently worked on asphalt paving on I-71 North near KY 329 (Crestwood/Pewee Valley). Additionally, new pavement markers have been installed for I-71 North and South, contributing to enhanced road safety.
