MAJOR PROJECT MILESTONE

Project Improvements Substantially Complete

Gov. Andy Beshear recently announced the substantial completion of the **I-Move Kentucky** project. This included critical ramp and interstate improvements as part of the initiative. It is one of the state's largest and most ambitious highway improvement projects covering more than 20 miles. Reaching this major milestone is a significant step toward enhancing safety, reducing congestion and improving traffic flow on three of Louisville's busiest interstates.

Just in time for the holiday season, the new interstate lanes and ramps open during daytime hours ensure that travelers and daily commuters enjoy a safer and smoother journey.

I-Move Kentucky project ramp and interstate improvements are substantially complete

I-Move Kentucky began construction in Spring 2020 and has completed several key infrastructure upgrades to improve safety and traffic flow across this corridor. These improvements include widening I-71 and the Gene Snyder Freeway from four to six lanes in both directions and reconfiguring the I-64/I-265 interchange with new flyover ramps.

This milestone highlights Kentucky's ongoing dedication to improving infrastructure for safer, more efficient roadways. Through I-Move, the state is not only enhancing traffic flow today but also laying the groundwork for continued economic growth and opportunities in the future.

Intermittent night and weekend closures ahead

While the bulk of the I-Move construction is now complete, sound wall installations and additional finishing touches such as signs, pavement markers and concrete repairs remain under way. This work will take place on nights and weekends and there could be lane closures during this time.
