Project milestone: Final bridge pour!

Exciting news! On Thursday, June 20, crews completed the final bridge pour for the ENTIRE I-Move Kentucky project area! This is a giant leap towards the project's completion.

This significant milestone was achieved during an early morning operation, with crews starting the pour around 2 a.m. and wrapping up by 7 a.m. Eventually, this bridge will carry vehicles on the new flyover ramp from I-265 North to I-64 West. Big progress on Blankenbaker Parkway Exit

Drivers, have you cruised by Blankenbaker Parkway recently? If so, you've probably noticed some exciting changes underway. Our hardworking crews are in full swing, expanding the westbound ramp to a spacious two lanes. That's right - we're talking TWO lanes!

Crews have already started paving for the new lane, and they've just wrapped up some median improvements as well. Keep an eye out for more progress on Blankenbaker Parkway.



New flyover ramp opened from I-64 East to I-265 North

The new flyover ramp from I-64 East to I-265 North opened on Sunday, June 9. By opening this new flyover ramp, one of the old cloverleaf ramps (Exit 19B) was removed. The replacement of the cloverleaf ramp increases overall safety, traffic flow and mobility for commuters.
