The I-Move Kentucky project crews are actively working toward the project's completion. With the holiday season approaching, we encourage everyone to travel slowly and safely through work zones by paying attention to road signage and staying alert for working crews.

Recently, all three lanes on I-71 opened to traffic in both directions. Crews are also making big strides in concrete paving the rest areas. Sound wall panels will be installed soon along the Brownsboro Road exit, and paving on the interchange is underway. Additionally, the ramp from I-64 eastbound to I-265 northbound is now open to both lanes. A lot happened across the project area in October, keep reading to learn more about all the great progress!

Great news for drivers! All three lanes on I-71 both northbound and southbound are now open to traffic. This important milestone improves traffic flow and safety for drivers just in time for the beginning of the holiday season!

Additionally, crews are concrete paving the rest areas along I-71 northbound and southbound. Metal bars are placed around the concrete to provide strength and help the concrete hold its shape as it sets.



Sound wall progress on Blankenbaker Parkway and Brownsboro Road

The sound walls at Blankenbaker Parkway have been completed! Crews are in the process of wrapping up on the exit ramp and drivers will soon be able to use the additional lane.

Meanwhile, work is progressing on the sound walls between Westport Road and Brownsboro Road exits on I-265. Columns have recently been set and the installation of panels has started. These barriers are essential for reducing noise pollution to create a more serene environment for residents.



Exciting progress on the I-64/I-265 interchange

The I-64/I-265 interchange has made significant progress, with paving on the new ramp connecting I-64 eastbound and I-265 northbound completed and the ramp now open fully to both lanes. Now that this ramp is complete, crews will begin to pave the final interchange ramp. This project is crucial for improving safety and easing traffic flow throughout the interchange.
