The **I-Move Kentucky** project is in the home stretch with crews working actively towards the project's completion. With all the new changes along the project area, be sure to use caution in work zones, watch for signage and stay alert for working crews.

Recently, a new ramp from I-64 West to I-265 North opened, which is the final new ramp of the project! Additionally, crews are making big strides on widening the Gene Snyder Freeway and Interstate 71. Panels will be installed soon for sound walls along the Blankenbaker Parkway ramp and blasting has finally concluded on I-71. A lot has happened across the project area in September, keep reading to learn more about the progress!

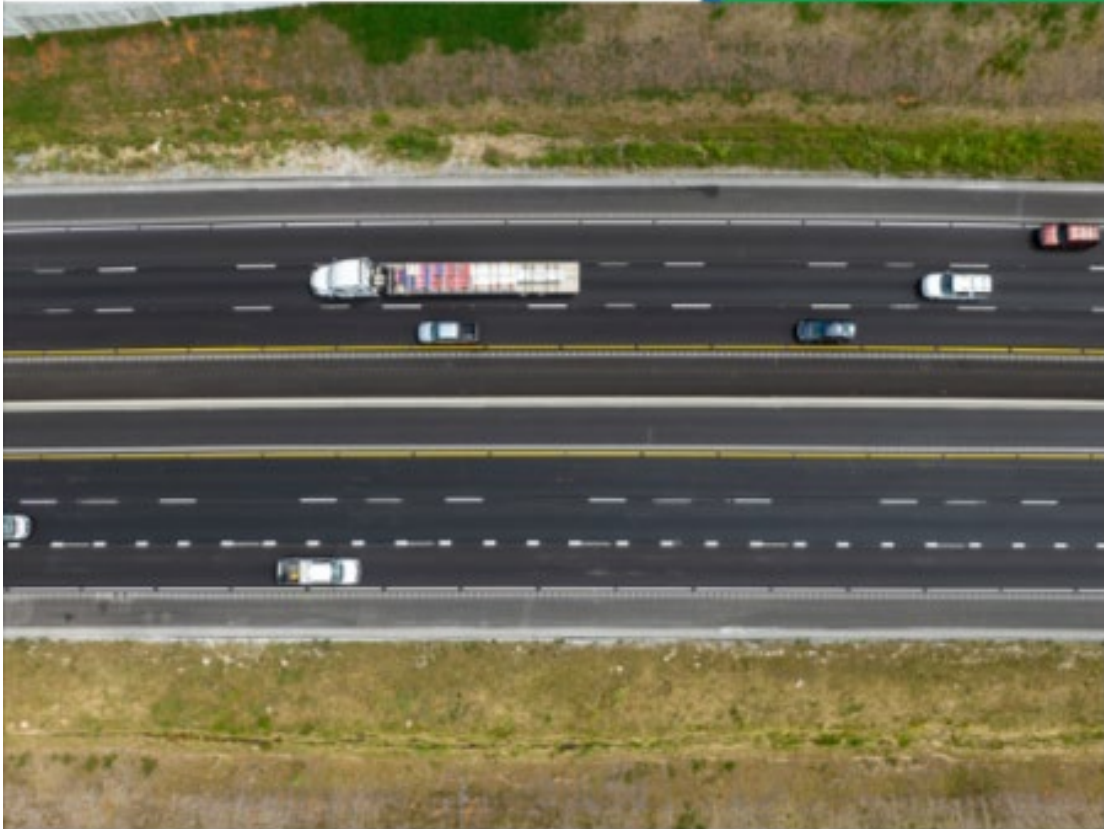


Final ramp of the project opened from I-64 West to I-265 North

On Tuesday, Sept. 10, the last ramp of the project area was officially opened to traffic. This new ramp facilitates traffic from I-64 West to I-265 North and will improve traffic flow and increase mobility for commuters.

Crews are also working on surface paving soon for the second lanes of the I-265 North to I-64 West ramp and the I-64 East to I-265 North ramp. Keep an eye out for upcoming traffic alerts on the I-265/I-64 interchange improvements.

Widening progress on I-265 and I-71

All of I-265 and most of I-71 have been successfully widened to three lanes. This major expansion is designed to improve traffic flow and enhance roadway safety. While crews are still actively working on final enhancements around Exit 14 and the rest areas along I-71, the newly completed sections are already making a noticeable difference for commuters. Temporary lane closures will occur as work continues to the end of the project, but this is a big step towards the completion of the project.



Exciting progress on Blankenbaker Parkway exit

Crews have installed all columns along the Blankenbaker Parkway exit for new sound walls. Now that all of the columns have been installed, panels will be added soon to complete the noise barriers in this area!

Crews have also been working to expand the westbound ramp to two lanes and surface work will happen soon. Keep an eye out for more progress as Blankenbaker Parkway improvements are closer to completion.



It's been a blast, I-71!

Blasting on I-71 has officially come to an end. The blasting was necessary to remove rock and other materials allowing for the widening of the roadway. During these operations, rolling road blocks were implemented to ensure the safety of both workers and drivers. Now that blasting is complete, crews can focus on surface work along Interstate 71.

The I-Move Kentucky project includes improvements to four major sections of I-265, I-71 and I-64 through a heavily traveled corridor in Jefferson and Oldham counties.
